Reconstruction

- Obtain materials for new garden
 - Wal-Mart for cardboard boxes
 - Bianchi Brickyard for mulch
 - Pepperoni Grill (very temporary materials)
 - City of BSL, soil
- Obtain Man Power
 - Sharpe Plumbing and Heating provided front loader
 - Green Man Lawn Service, provided trailer for cardboard
 - Troop 38, provided workday man power
 - BSL Volunteer Fire Dept. to wet cardboard













First Troop Workday Complete

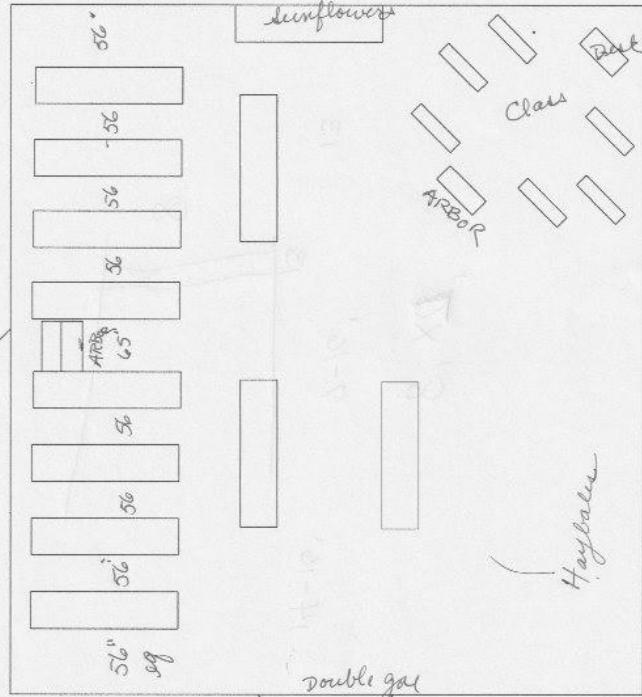




Next Phase
