8. Committee/Board Reports and Minutes ~

a. Community Appearance Committee

Ann Hollingsworth reported that the committee has had 10 newcomers to welcome for the month of June and 5 new property recognitions. We enjoyed the Battle of the Bands at Spring Lake. The committee is distributing surveys to the BSL Community Center to find out what improvements and additions our citizens would like in regard to our existing programs.

b. Planning Board

Gene Fiorvante reported they are still discussing the patio, multi-purpose houses and cluster homes.

c. Parks & Recreation Advisory Board

Commissioner Glidden reported that she filled in for Commissioner Stilwell at the last meeting and they had a presentation on alligators and the strongest message was do not feed the alligators. Parks & Rec. is working on the survey and there are sheets are in the lobby if anyone would like to fill one out.

d. Special Events

Commissioner Glidden reported that they will not be meeting in the month of July but they are working on getting gifts and donations for the Mayor's Cup which will be in August.

9. City Manager's Report ~ Jeff Repp

City Manager Repp reported as of May 31, 2014 the city had \$2,591,676 in cash and investments. Our city attorney sent a letter to Peter Metz of Reeves Telecom on the Orphan Roads and we are waiting to hear back if they will sign off on the Orphan Roads that are still under the name of Reeves Telecom. When we get that document back we will then be able to put it before the Board for approval and then submit it to the State for Powell Bill funding. Public Works has finished its second mowing of the season prior to the July 4th holiday; with the 3rd moving beginning shortly. Emergency Management held a teleconference this afternoon on Tropical Storm Arthur. They are expecting wind and rain to start on Thursday afternoon with the storm dissipating by July 4th. We will continue to monitor the storm and the lake levels in our City. Citizens will be notified if the Big Lake will be lowered. Testing for water quality on the lakes that have swimming has been done in June and we will starting testing for the month of July. There are three tests on water quality which are done, if two of the three tests exceed levels that are recommended by the state, those lakes will be closed for swimming and be retested. So

far there is only one lake that has been closed and we will be retesting that lake at the end of the month.
