3. Mr. Repp explained today's meeting is a workshop for the Board of Commissioners. There are two items on the agenda; the first item will be an update on the dam reconstruction project. Mr. Michael Hanson of McGill Engineering will provide background on the process. We are now at the 90% phase of the engineered drawings, which were submitted last week to North Carolina Dam Safety for review, and the issuance of a construction permit. This will allow the City to proceed toward requesting contractors to submit their bids.

Mr. Repp explained the second item on the agenda today will be a review with County official John Nicholas, Director of Public Utilities for Brunswick County, Brunswick County Commissioner Mike Forte and Mr. Carter Hubard, Vice President, Wilmington Regional Manager, W. K. Dickson. As you may remember in June of 2020, the Board of Commissioners sent a letter to the County requesting a draft citywide sewer study that had been prepared with a number of questions. The County is here today to provide feedback on those questions.







Schedule

- Durations from Contractors ranged from 2.5 to 4 years with an average of 3 years
- Engineer's estimate is 3-4 years
- Cost will increase as duration limit reduces
- Example: Paving Drayton Road (est. \$550K) would allow PLD and NLD to proceed in parallel which could save 3-4 months. This is currently an Alternate Bid Item.
- Consider adding incentives










BACKGROUND

- 2010 CITY AND COUNTY ENTER INTO AGREEMENT SEWER ASSESSMENT DISTRICT IN COMMERCIAL AREA
- EARLY 2020 COUNTY PROVIDES CITY-WIDE SEWER MASTERPLAN TO PROVIDE GUIDANCE FOR DEVELOPERS INTERESTED IN EXTENDING THE EXISTING SEWER SYSTEM
- JULY 2020 CITY EXPRESSES INTEREST IN CITY-WIDE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT AND REQUESTS THE COUNTY TO PROVIDE INFORMATION TO HELP DETERMINE COST ESTIMATES
- COSTS DECEMBER 2020 - W.K. DICKSON COMPLETES TECHNICAL MEMORANDUM THAT DETAILS





FEES AND/OR SEWER TRANSMISSION CAPITAL RECOVERY FEES FOR EXISTING HOMEOWNERS WILLING TO "WOULD THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AGREE TO A WAIVER PERIOD FOR SEWER CAPITAL RECOVERY CONNECT TO THE SEWER SYSTEM WITHIN A DESIGNATED TIME PERIOD?"

BC BOARD ANSWER - YES

PREVIOUS AGREEMENT LANGUAGE

TO PAY THE SEWER CAPITAL RECOVERY FEE, SEWER TRANSMISSION CAPITAL RECOVERY FEE, TAP FEE, AND TAP FEE TO INCLUDE THE GRINDER PUMP SYSTEM THAT DO NOT VOLUNTARILY CONNECT TO THE SYSTEM WITHIN 60 DAYS OF NOTIFICATION OF SYSTEM COMPLETION WILL BE REQUIRED "IN ADDITION TO THE ASSESSMENT, PARCELS WITH EXISTING STRUCTURES AT THE TIME OF COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION OF THE COLLECTION

CAPITAL RECOVERY FEE AND SEWER TRANSMISSION CAPITAL RECOVERY FEE. PROPERTY OWNERS THAT CONNECTED WITHIN THE TIME FRAME WERE NOT REQUIRED TO PAY A SEPARATE GRINDER AND TAP FEE OR THE SEWER THIS WAS LATER ADJUSTED TO GIVE A 1-YEAR WAIVER PERIOD FOR THE CAPITAL RECOVERY FEE AND SEWER TRANSMISSION CAPITAL RECOVERY FEE


