## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BOILING SPRING LAKES, NORTH CAROLINA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Boiling Spring Lakes, North Carolina, that:

Section 1. The fiscal year 2021 budget covering fiscal operations during the period of July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021, was set forth by Ordinance,
