Consideration to add "Trailer Park" or "RV Park" to C1 and /or Light Industrial Tabled Item ~July 9, 2013 meeting

Discussion ~

Bill Clark explained information he received from Oak Island and Southport about their RV/Trailer Parks. Their RV Park is one item, a Trailer Park with permanent trailers, temporary trailers and self propelled. They have regulations on the size of the lots, minimum twenty foot wide by forty seven long, minimum of twenty feet between pads. Thirty foot drive between pads as a right of way. For every pad there needs to be two hundred square foot of space for a play or recreation area. There is a buffer zone requirement to screen them from the street. They would use county or city water. Under sewer they have an option to either hook up to the sewer or have a self contained site septic that would get pumped ~for Oak Island. For an application they want a site plan and civil plan, surrounding property shall be what it is adjoined to.

Ray Rumsey explained he would prefer not to see a trailer park in the city. Bill Clark explained it is a legal entity. David Putnam agreed with Ray Rumsey he would rather not see a trailer park in the city but if someone comes in and submits an application for one it has to get consideration. Bill Clark explained right now there is no application. Other cities have a separate application with different requirements than if you were to build a house or business.

Ray Rumsey asked to expand the search for more information. He would like to see information from a city that has just an RV Park or campground.

Bill Clark will gather more information about RV Parks / Campgrounds.

A motion was made by David Putnam and seconded by Gene Fiorvante to table RV/Trailer Park to a future date taking Trailer Park out of the equation.
