### a. Recap of Spring Fling Event

Ann Hollingsworth mentioned to Melissa that this was the best year for the Appearance Committee at Spring Fling because they had a lot more people visit their tent and she was able to provide a lot of information. There was a big article in the *State Port Pilot* for the Jack Helbig Memorial Foundation which the members felt brought more people to the event and hoped it helped raise awareness for the cause.
