A motion was made by Joan and seconded by Mary to approve the proposed budget.

Ernie suggested we order some different colored shirts. Jackie said if we need to order shirts all we need to do is call Brandall and order them. Next meeting we can decide what we want to do regarding shirts when everyone is in attendance. Ernie said he wears a 2X if we decide to order.

VII. New Business

a. Senior Class Parade – South Brunswick High School

There was discussion regarding the parade. Decorating the trees on Hwy 87 with bows, and a banner as we did last year. Joan has the bows from last year and all decided we should add white ribbon to the bows to make them stand out more. Ernie suggested we get a banner that we could change the year each year. Jackie said she did not think we could get that kind of banner for a

reasonable price. Jackie will design the congratulation banner and Joan will order the white ribbon and get ties to attach the white ribbon to the bows. A motion was made by Joan and seconded by Brenda that we spend no more than \$300 out of our Special Account for the banner and ribbons.

a. City of BSL's 60th Anniversary Celebration

Jackie read an email from Commissioner Guzulaitis regarding us helping with a celebration for the city's 60th anniversary in September. After discussion all agreed we would like to help and that Jackie would send an email back to Commissioner Guzulaitis saying we would be happy to help and we suggest a committee be established with 2 representatives from the city's committees, along with the Police Department, Parks and Rec Dept and BSL Fire/Rescue. Special Events Committee is ready to have 2 representatives help if a committee is established. Jackie volunteered to do the flyers. Jackie will send the committee members a draft of her email to Commissioner Guzulaitis before she sends it out.
