I. Call to Order

Brenda Hogan called the regular (rescheduled) monthly meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

IV. Public Comment

The representatives expressed an interest in taking part in future Special Events Committee Eggstravaganza, Mayor's Cup, etc., and this year, combining Trunk or Treat with the Special Events Fall Festival (October 22, 2022). Chris Sims explained her 30 years of involvement (in her previous neighborhood), stating "community involvement is

key." She explained how in her 30 years of involvement and experience with Parks and Recreation she has never witnessed Parks and Recreation and Special Events Committee being two separate entities. Stating "it's very unusual."

Parks and Recreation representatives agreed that Special Events could hold the Fall Festival, utilizing the area to the left of the Community Center building, as well as the inside bathrooms. Disc golf will cease during the hours of the Fall Festival.

Chris also indicated that last year Trunk or Treat provided treats to 250 trick or treaters.

Brenda pointed out that Trunk or Treat has always been on Halloween.

Parks and Recreation representatives agreed to move Trunk or Treat to October 29, as Halloween is on a Monday this year.

It was decided that both Committee and Department would table combining Trunk or Treat with the Fall Festival until 2023.

On April 1, 2023 Parks and Recreation will host Founder's Day.

V. Old Business

Lucille has calculated monies from the Mayor's Cup and the Committee will be presenting the Boiling Spring Lakes Fire Department with a check for \$1536.50, during the Commissioners Meeting at City Hall Tuesday October 4. Arrive by 6:15 p.m. in your blue Committee t-shirt.

Brittany will do photography while riding the course in a golf cart.

It was decided that Joan will write "Thank You" notes for the 2022 sponsors.

Lucille has a meeting set for Monday September 26, at City Hall to go over our budget.

The 50/50 raffle winner donated \$140 back to our Committee.

Karen made a motion that the Committee retain the \$140 donation, with a second by Brenda.

We discussed whether candy should be donated (ie: Lowe's / Walmart) or purchased from Oriental Trade.

Mary will create an announcement for Facebook, Next Door and the City of Boiling Spring Lakes cites by October 1, 2022. Brenda volunteered to distribute them around the city.

We would like a commitment from the Fire Department or the VFW is we buy the food (Costco) and they prepare it and they keep the proceeds.

Lucille gave Mary the name and phone number of the fortuneteller from prior Fall Festivals.

Joan will contact her South Brunswick High School Key Club advisor, in an attempt to have volunteers/helpers for the activities. Musical chairs, Costume contest-best girl/best boy (0 mos. – 4 yrs., 5yrs. – 8yrs., 9 yrs. – 13yrs.)

Honey will do the tombstone walk, with mini cupcake prizes!

Karen will get 40 solar powered lights for the trail.

We will have face painting.

Lucille will contact previous spooky scene creators (Ernie, PD, FD). In the past the first prize winner of the Spookiest Scene was awarded \$200. A motion was made by Mary with a second from Brenda to increase the prize to \$250.
