City Urges Residents to Sign up for Emergency Notifications with CodeRED System

The City of Boiling Spring Lakes is making efforts to prepare its residents and citizens for disaster by signing up with the Code RED Emergency Notification on its city website (www.cityofbsl.org) or calling City Hall (844-363-0025 or 910-363-0025)

"While everyone knows it's important to prepare, the City wants to ensure that everyone knows exactly what to do in the event of a disaster. The CodeRED system enhances communications between residents and the City public safety personnel by sending telephone calls, text messages, emails and social media alerts in an effort to effectively inform residents to protect life and property" stated City Manager Jeff Repp.

City officials urge all residents to enroll to receive emergency alerts through CodeRED. Those who have already enrolled to receive CodeRED notifications but have recently moved or changed telephone numbers are encouraged to visit the City website at <u>www.cityofbsl.org</u> and click on the CodeRED logo to register or update their contact information.

"We ask residents to encourage their family members, friends, colleagues and other groups about the CodeRED system and make sure they are in the emergency database. We will rely on the CodeRED system to keep our community informed during disaster, but we need to make sure we have your contact information," added Mr. Repp

Those without Internet access may call City Hall (844-363-0025 or 910-363-0025), Monday through Friday, (8AM-4:30PM)] to subscribe to receive CodeRED alerts by supplying their information over the phone.
