Dam Project Update

Upper Lake Dam Impounded July 21, 2026 – Significant filling has occurred since.

North Lake Dam – Lakebed clearing continues (approximately 60% complete). Will be eligible for impoundment once clearing is complete.

Sanford Dam – Fill Placement and Concrete Work continues. Expected Completion Q1 2027.

Pine Lake Dam – Demolition to correct dam structure has begun (approximately 80% complete), concrete work to begin this week. Expected Completion Q1 2027.

Reminder: Contracted final completion date is May 18, 2027.

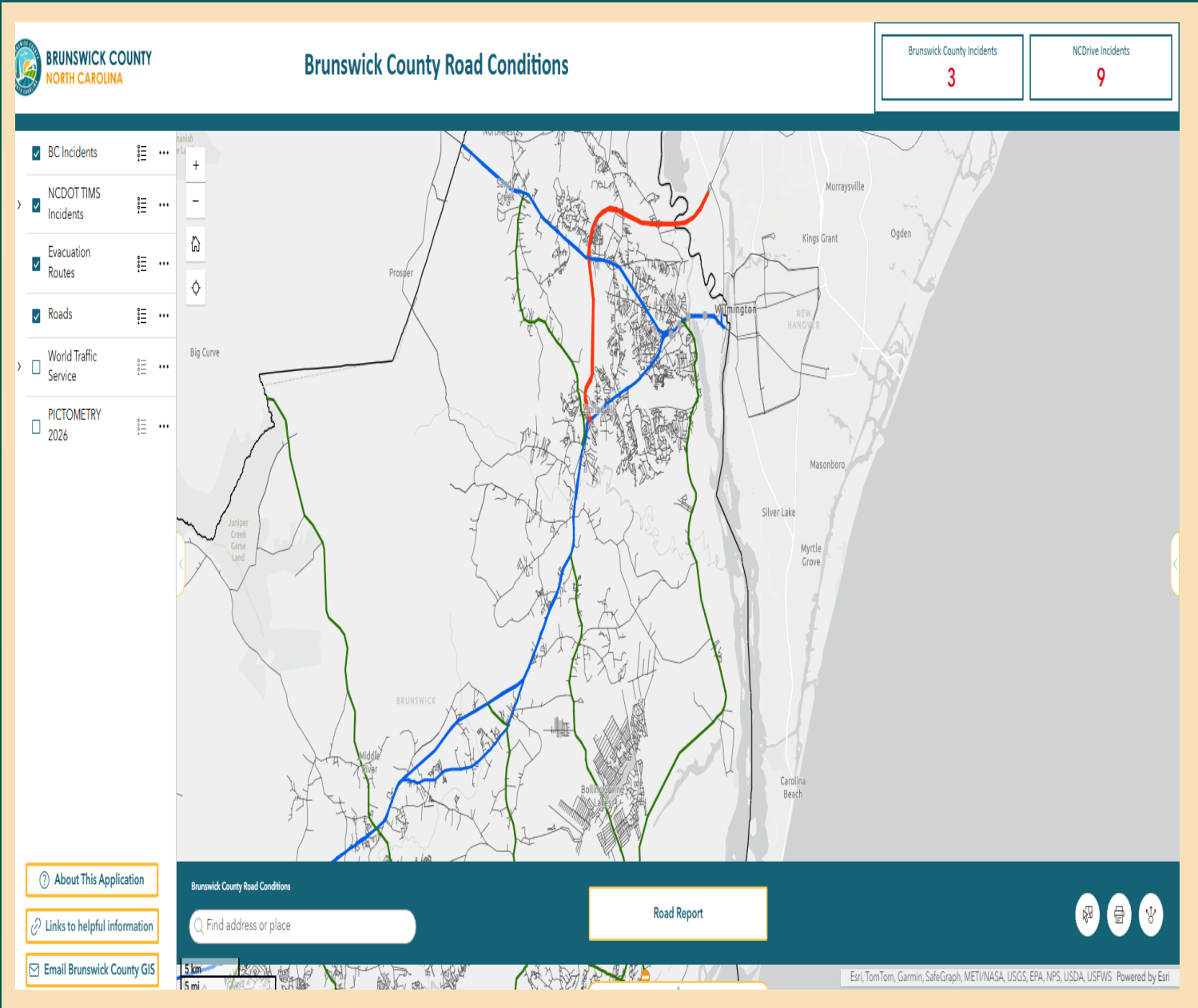
